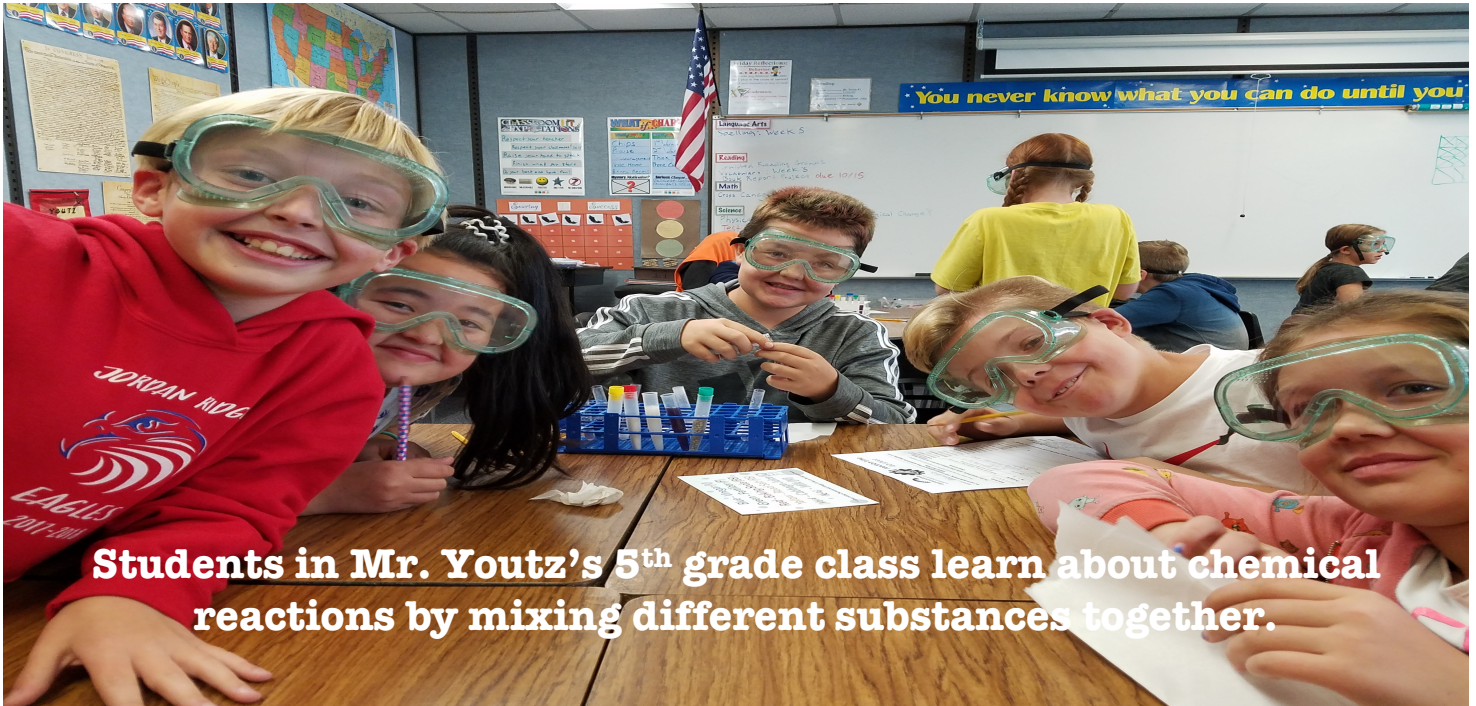

NOVEMBER 21

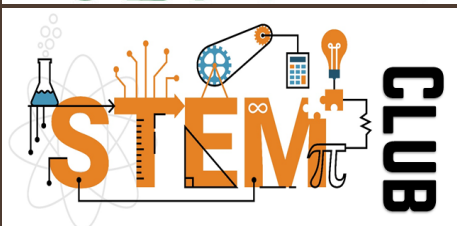
EARLY OUT DAY!

Wear your pajamas to school as part of our spirit day.

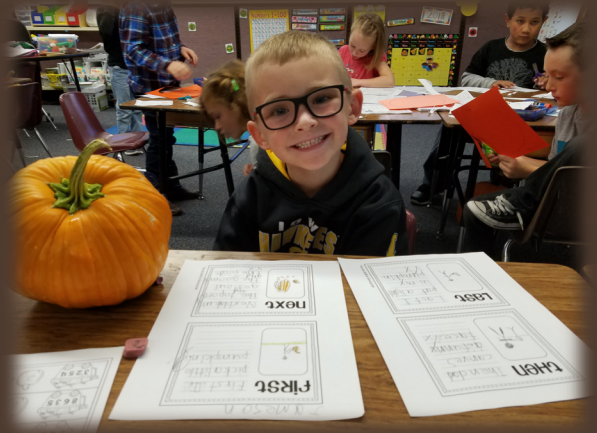


WE NEED YOUR HELP WITH CLUBS!

Above: A student in Mrs. McDougal's class practices explanatory writing by writing about the steps required to carve a jack-o-lantern.

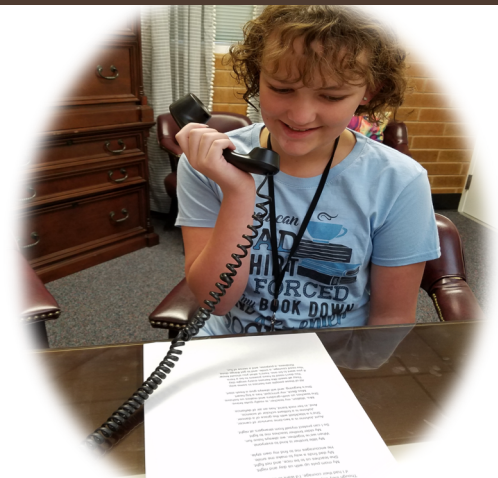


PTA REFLECTIONS
